NOTES FOR EXTERNAL CANDIDATES

A number of places in our Sixth Form are usually available every year to good candidates from other schools. If you are an external candidate and you wish to apply for a place here, the procedure is as follows:

1) Please complete an application form and return to: -

Applications are required at the latest by the end of the February prior to the September in which you wish to join the Sixth Form. Later applications may be considered.

- 2) On receipt of the application form **we will write to your existing Head teacher** asking for verification of your predicted G.C.S.E. grades.
- 3) If you are a suitable candidate and there is the possibility of making you an offer, **you will then be asked to visit the School to discuss options and aspects of Sixth Form life** and to be given a tour of the School. This will normally be with the Head of Sixth Form.
- 4) If your School verifies your predicted grades and if, **after the School's Admissions' criteria have been applied**, a place is available for the combination of subjects you wish to study, you will be offered a place for the coming September. The offer will be conditional on you achieving the required G.C.S.E. grades when these are published in August (i.e.: at least 48 points from your best eight G.C.S.E. subjects with a minimum of 3 grade A's when A* = 8 points, A = 7, B = 6 etc. – and at least a B grade in the subjects you wish to study to AS level). Please note that only 1 maths grade can count towards the 48 points.

You will probably be notified of our decision about whether to offer you a place around Easter and we would ask for a firm reply by return.

- 5) If we can offer you a place and subsequently you change your mind about coming here, it is essential that you let us know immediately. This will enable us to offer the place to another candidate. The number of external candidates applying for a place here is always far in excess of the number of places available.
- 6) The offer of a place will be for the subjects you originally indicated you wished to study. We cannot guarantee a place if you subsequently change your options after you have accepted our offer.
- 7) If we cannot offer you a place in the spring then you may wish to contact us again on GCSE Results Day in August when sometimes places become available.
