**NOTES FOR EXTERNAL CANDIDATES**

A number of places in our Sixth Form are usually available every year to good candidates from other schools. If you are an external candidate and you wish to apply for a place here, the procedure is as follows:

**1) Please complete an application form and return to: -**

**Applications are required to be returned by 29<sup>th</sup> February 2012.**

- 2) Upon receipt of your application we will write to the Head Teacher of your current school requesting a reference and an indication of your predicted grades.
- 3) If you are a suitable candidate and there is the possibility of making you an offer, you may then be asked to visit the School to discuss options and aspects of Sixth Form life and to be given a tour of the School. This will normally be with the Head of Sixth Form (Mr K Pearson).
- 4) If your School verifies your predicted grades and if, **after the School's Admissions' criteria have been applied**, a place is available for the combination of subjects you wish to study, you will be offered a place for the coming September. The offer will be conditional on you achieving the required G.C.S.E. grades when these are published in August (i.e.: at least 48 points from your best eight G.C.S.E. subjects with a minimum of 3 grade A's when A\* = 8 points, A = 7, B = 6 etc. – and at least a B grade in the subjects you wish to study to AS level). **Please note that only 1 math's grade can count towards the 48 points/ 3 A grades requirement.**
- 5) **Notification of offers will normally be sent at the beginning of April and we would ask for a firm reply in writing by immediate return.**  
  
**If you are offered a place here and accept but then change your mind at a later date, it is essential that you let us know immediately in order that we can accommodate other applicants.**
- 6) The offer of a place will be for the subjects you originally indicated you wished to study. We cannot guarantee a place if you subsequently change your options after you have accepted our offer.
- 7) If we cannot offer you a place in the Spring Term then you may wish to contact us again on GCSE Results Day in August when sometimes places become available.
