What is Chad's Challenges?

Objective:

To raise loads of money, to have fun, make people smile and to keep the special memory of Chad alive within Altrincham Grammar School for Boys (AGSB) and the wider community.

Mission Statement:

Chad is our inspiration. He will be remembered for many reasons but by running this charitable group, we will show some of Chad's endeavour, determination and sense of fun to students who join AGSB.

Sixth Form Students from the School will work together with and receive guidance from Michelle Mulholland and her family, to raise funds (by events or donations) which are passed on to various charities. At the start of each fund raising year the team will agree a focus of charities for the year. Funds may be given to registered charities or could be used to make payments to help other projects or people.

The Committee:

Chair – Michelle Mulholland and Gill Williamson

Committee members – up to 5 members of the Sixth Form (ideally 2 from Year 12, who will continue in the role when they move to Year 13, and 3 from Year 13)

Financial Matters:

Chad's Challenges will not be a registered charity. No member of the Committee will be paid wages from participating in the events. Each event will have a destination agreed for the funds raised, which will be known and publicised as part of the event. With the agreement of the Committee, funds may be used set up other events, with the purpose of increasing the overall value of the fund. For example, £50 could be used to buy ingredients for making cakes before a "tea party".

Funds raised to be paid on to registered charities will be held within AGSB accounts by our School Finance Team. This team will also raise cheques as instructed by the Committee when the funds are to be distributed. Letters accompany all payments. The main focus of donations will be to the Chadwick Mulholland Much Loved Fund at The Christie : <http://chadwick.mulholland.muchloved.com/> but we do raise money for other good causes.

Events:

Events held under the "Chad's Challenges" umbrella must be approved by the Committee. In addition donations will be accepted from other events, from within and outside AGSB. For example a recent school play donated part of the profit to Chads Challenges. The Chair, however, has the power to veto events or decline donations that may be inappropriate.
