Altrincham Grammar School Developments Ltd (AGSD) is an independent charitable organisation that was established in 1998. Our sole function is to raise funds for Altrincham Grammar School for Boys for vital projects and buildings. The aim is to give every boy attending the school the best experience from the use of the best facilities. With this bedrock we are hoping to give pupils the means to achieve their full potential

MEET THE TEAM

Although AGSD is a fundraiser for AGSB it is a completely separate organisation which is run and managed on a voluntarily basis. Our volunteers are parents of pupils or past pupils at the school. We are united in our common aim to keep AGSB evolving so pupils attending the school now and joining in the future will benefit from the advancements in new buildings, equipment and technology.

AGSD has been the heart of a considerable amount of investment in the school's infrastructure over the past 20 years. Many areas of the school such as the dining hall, art studio, science block and technology block were in much need of renovation and modernisation. AGSD helped to raise funds so these areas could be replaced or refurbished to a high standard.

As well as funding renovation projects AGSD has also helped fund new buildings including the Sixth Form Centre, Language College, Physics Centre, and The Grammar, all of which have had a profoundly positive impact on the education and health of the students.

THE HEADMASTERS MESSAGE

In sending your child to Altrincham Grammar School for Boys, you have enabled them to attend a Top 25 state school, which strives for and achieves academic excellence. In 2020, 82% of our boys achieved top grades (7-9) at GCSE with an excellent progress score of +1.2. Typically, 84% of our 'A' Level students obtain A*-B. Stunning academic results are not, however, our only strength here at AGSB. We also place special onus on developing the boys outside the classroom with our extensive extra-curricular programme.

Following year-on-year government budget cuts to education, we have had to make significant reductions in school expenditure. Over 80% of our government income is spent on salaries for staff as well as every day running costs.



To ensure that government income cuts do not impact the education we offer our boys, we rely on your support. Without parents contributing to AGSD, we would not have been able to afford key facilities and resources such as:

- The Physics building
- The Sports Hall and Astro Pitch
- The 6th Form Centre
- The new teaching complex (the building was completed in December 2020)

As a School, we are working hard to ensure that the AGSB Experience – the thing that makes this school so special to our pupils – is not threatened. But to do this, we need your help.

How can you help?





WHAT YOUR FUNDS HAVE HELPED TO BUILD SO FAR...












which contributions have helped to dramatically improve and evolve the school. Improvements which will be enjoyed by the current cohort and future ones to come.

Proposed new projects include a new reception area, a music school, a 4G Pitch and increasing the catering space. Developments like these require considerable amounts of capital - to build and fit out.

Funds are available from the government and private sector, but to earn these the school must be able to show it's made possible through the generous donations of parents own financial commitment to the project for a bid to be successful. This is where AGSD and the vital contribution made by the parents come in. AGSD raises funds not from large individual donations, but from regular smaller scale The new school expansion is one of the many ways in commitments (e.g. £25 a month), currently made by over half of the pupils' parents. The bid for the current school expansion was only successful due to an AGSD contribution of £370,000. Ongoing and future plans cannot be contemplated without AGSD underwriting feasibility, planning and bid costs.

> As an independent charity we are able to claim gift aid (where the school is not) and, significantly, why our funds are crucial for obtaining funding from both government and

at AGSB. It provides the much needed early monetary support to 'win' any bids from the government or other private investors for development of the school. AGSD funding thus creates a leverage effect: AGSD showed a commitment of £300,000 for the new teaching complex which gave rise to the government funding of just under £3million. This is why AGSD is so crucial.

Although we have been very successful in the past with income reaching £100,000 p.a., we now face particularly difficult economic times. Cutbacks in government funding leave schools needing to top-up the short fall for on-going projects, so your help is needed now more than ever. Currently we have over 500 members but we need to grow this number if we are to continue to grow the school. AGSB is a non fee-paying state school so there is no compulsion to contribute. However AGSD makes a huge difference through its voluntary contributions. 100% membership would have a major impact on what we can achieve for all our future projects.
