Dear Parents, Carers and Students

I hope that half-term went well for all involved. The term has resumed at pace and it is reassuring that Covid cases remain extremely low. You will have now received a letter from Mr Soulsby following the announcement by the Prime Minister of the removal of measures put in place as a response to the COVID-19 pandemic. While we hope that we are moving out of the pandemic, vigilance remains important.

We are currently in the process of migrating to a new Management Information System (MIS), replacing SIMS with Arbor. As it is a cloud-based system, it will facilitate a number of functions under one cover, as well as saving the School money on a number of bolt-on software programmes. As with any change of MIS, there will be a few teething problems over the next few weeks so thank you in advance for your patience.

In assemblies this week I praised Year 11 and Year 13 students for the way they conducted themselves in the Trial Examinations. Early signs are very encouraging however, Trial Exams are exactly that, and should provide very useful information to help students prepare for the public examinations which are to take place in the summer.

I am pleased to report that the Whole School Council have returned to action. We have a Pupil Voice system at AGSB which allows every single member of the school to have their voice heard. The constitution of the School Council at AGSB is a multi-layered approach. First, we have form time discussions, where the Form Captains facilitate discussion to find out what are the pupils' priorities. Secondly the Form Captain leadership team sit as a year group and decide their year group's priorities. Finally, two democratically elected members of each year group attend a Whole School Council Meeting chaired by the 6th Form Senate. Discussions were excellent at every level of the process and were mainly focused around the need for additional water dispensers; yard space usage; a review of the one-way system; computer access in the new Library; a BYOD policy review; canteen queues for KS4 pupils; bag storage issues and ICT access.

Pastoral care remains at the top of our agenda and this year we have introduced Pastoral Support lunchtime sessions with your child's Head of Year. These sessions are designed to provide students with extra support in a variety of areas. If you feel that your child would welcome some extra support, please do contact the relevant Head of Year.

This week AGSB has been taking part in Altrincham Stand up to Cancer. Morning assemblies have raised awareness informing pupils on the sad reality of cancer - but also how the spread can be prevented with donations and support. AGSB has dedicated the week to fundraising for The Christie Hospice. Well done to Taiyyib, Sammy, Yaser and Haidar who have done an incredible job of raising awareness to this crucial subject.

Finally, in sport this week we endured some tough rugby fixtures vs St. Ambrose, however, congratulations to the Under 16 Hockey squad who are now Cheshire Champions and to our U18's who have progressed through Round 4 of the National Knockout with a great win against Worksop College.

I wish you and your families well for the weekend ahead.

History Enrichment Trip



Eighteen of AGSB's Year 9 students participated in what was a unique and informative experience, exploring Manchester's statues and monuments on Tuesday 8th February. The students, led by Mr Croxton and Mr Sampson (many thanks to them both), studied memorials that celebrated and reflected upon figures and events that helped pioneer Manchester into what it is today. This was in perhaps a more direct way, in addition to memorials for those


that may not have necessarily had a personal link to the city, but helped changed the lives of the people there. These included monuments erected both more historically and more recently.

We were privileged to see a great variety of memorials, amounting to ten in total, educated on each by the vast knowledge of Mr Croxton. Some examples included: the 'Victory Over Blindness' statue outside Piccadilly Train Station; the Emmaline Pankhurst statue, opposite the Central Library and the monument honouring those who lost their lives at St Peter's Field during the Peterloo Massacre.

As a result of this trip, we were able to gather a fuller picture of the City and its importance on a global scale in history. Again, thanks to both Mr. Croxton and Mr. Sampson for organising and leading this trip.

AGSB Islamic Society



In 2016, the AGSB Islamic Society ran its first **Unity Through Charity Campaign** to raise money for Syrians in need. The campaign was a huge success, raising more than five times the initial target and uniting the whole School Community in the process. As part of the project, an **Asian Food Sale** was organised where Arab & Indian foods in particular were sold by the ISOC to staff and students. Since then, the food sale has been run every year (except in 2021 due to Covid). Each year we have striven to improve the menu and make necessary changes to the sale to help raise more money for those in need. In doing so, we have also raised

awareness of several different global causes and conflicts from the civil war in Yemen to the refugee crisis in Bangladesh.

This year, we are partnering with **Salam Charity** to help fund the construction of deep water wells in Pakistan. For some, the concept of a tap is unimaginable, to have clean water ready on demand for all desires and needs. We want to make this dream a reality through our fundraising this year. Beyond this, we also intend on donating some of the money raised towards the cardiac surgeries of children in particular, who have developed or inherited heart problems due to malnutrition and/or poor drinking water quality.

School Assemblies will take place all next week to raise awareness of the situation and there will be an Own Clothes Day on Friday 11th March to raise further funds.
