Simon delivered an inspirational talk to four Year Groups about the importance of self-belief how to work sustainably to reach your 'biggest goals'. 

In May of this year, two teams of AGSB pupils - the 'PiHeads' and team 'Graviton', had their experiments run on the International Space Station!

Below you can see their Certificate which shows the date and times that their experiments ran for as well as the position of the ISS above the Earth's surface as their code ran in orbit. As well as being involved in something so amazing they are all recipients of the prestigious and rarely awarded AGSB science award!





We receieved fanatstic news from the AstroPi team last

when we learned that two of this year's teams, DrPi and LosPolos have also progressed through Phase 1 and have now been asked to complete their coding for consideration to run on the ISS. A brand new Raspberry Pi with cameras and filters among the accessories has been awarded to our teams by the AstroPi organisers for their efforts to enable this design phase. Here's hoping one or both teams can replicate last year's success and get their experiments into orbit!
