

Particle Physics Masterclass



On the 29th March, 14 Year 12 students took part in the annual Daresbury Laboratory Particle Physics Masterclass. There were some excellent speakers who gave talks to pupils about their work at Daresbury. The first lectures were on how particle accelerators work, utilising electric and magnetic fields and how they're used in accelerators. There was also a tour of the Boulby Underground Laboratory, which was built to try and detect dark matter, which means it is positioned over a kilometre underground to shield form the Earth's natural

background radiation! There was a lecture from the Diamond Light Source in Oxford, focussing on how they use particle accelerators to generate X-rays to use in high energy experiments.

The interactive virtual course covered a variety of topics ranging from the key fundamental scientific ideas such as the standard model to the inner workings of particle accelerators. The well-orchestrated experience provided a complete synoptic breakdown of the many complex components involved in the cutting-edge research at a molecular scale. This was followed by an interactive discussion of the many career paths that stemmed from the particle research and application facilities which was made effortless and effective by the web-based audience interaction tool, Slido. Overall, the event was extremely beneficial as it gave a significantly greater understanding than our classroom-level understanding, and I would highly recommend it to any aspiring physicists or innovators.


