AGSB has been in the news of late. In November, The Manchester Evening News reported that AGSB has the best record for sending students to Oxford or Cambridge University of any state-run Secondary School in Greater Manchester. Last weekend, the School was announced as The Times & Sunday Times North West School of the Year 2024 for Academic Performance. Although I am not the greatest advocate of School League tables, it is welcoming to receive such accolades and I would like to thank our hardworking students, their families, our incredible teaching and support staff and the dedicated team of Governors and Trustees.

The final week in November belonged to the AGSB production of 'West Side Story'', a musical inspired by William Shakespeare's play, Romeo and Juliet. The cast consisted of AGSB students from Years 8 to 13 and was complemented by a number of students from AGGS, Sale GS and Loreto GS. Mrs Hildage provided the choreography with Musical Direction led by our Director of Music, Mr Monument.

We are extremely proud of everyone involved in this project and their incredible professionalism throughout rehearsals and during show week.

Congratulations also go to our musicians. The AGSB Concert Band and Big Band enjoyed a very successful day at the National Concert Band Festival (NCBF) Regionals last Sunday which took place at Warwick School. The Concert Band were awarded a Platinum Award, the highest possible award and the Big Band were awarded a Gold. We are extremely proud of them.

In sport, the Senior Indoor Hockey Squad face the best seven schools in the country when they travel to London this week for the National Finals. Good luck also to the 1<sup>st</sup> XI football squad who take on Wilmslow High School in their bid to make to the last sixteen schools in the country. There have also been fantastic victories this week for the Under 14 and 16 Badminton squads who have reached the Regional Final and to the Under 14 and 16 Basketball squads who both defeated BTH on Wednesday.

Over the past two weeks, the School has welcomed back two Old Alt's who are making a name for themselves in Politics. Leader of Trafford Council, Tom Ross, delivered an enlightening talk about local Government politics and Oliver Carroll, who is the Conservative Candidate to replace Sir Graham Brady as MP, gave a fascinating talk about his journey to being a prospective MP and issues affecting our constituency. I am very proud to announce that Parent Power, The Times & Sunday Times Schools' Guide 2024, has ranked Altrincham Grammar School for Boys the top State Secondary School in the North West for Academic Performance. The guide, which is now available online has considered Schools' Public Exam results from the Summer of 2023.

This year, 28% of AGSB A Level grades were at A\*, 64% were A\*-A and 85% of passes were at A\*- B, a higher proportion than in any year before 2020. The average grade awarded was an A, and 19 Altrincham Grammar School for Boys students achieved A\* for all their A level subjects.

In 2022, AGSB also had the best record in terms of the proportion of its A Level students who went to Oxbridge. The 18 successful students worked out at just over one in 10 pupils (10.1%), which is a larger percentage than at any other state-funded Secondary School or College in our region.

All-Party Parliamentary Group on North Korea, in addition to serving as an Open Doors Spokesperson for Korea. He regularly speaks at conferences in the UK and internationally, including the 49th and 52nd
