Dear Parents, Carers and Students

Yesterday in assembly, the AGSB community paid their respects to all those affected by the series of devastating earthquakes hitting Turkey and Syria on Monday, 6th February 2023. All students have been made aware that if they are experiencing difficulties or suffering anxiety or upset, and would like some extra support, or just want someone to talk to, they should contact their Head of Year or Mr Hall (Deputy Head – Pastoral).

Furthermore, the AGSB Islamic Society will be holding their Asian Food Sale shortly after we return from half-term (13th and 14th March) and they will be donating the monies raised to the Earthquake Appeal. There will also be an "Own Clothes Day" on the 17th March to raise further funds for the relief effort.





Chess Club



Year 12 Physics Olympiad



Our Year 12 students have again taken part in the British Physics Olympiad which is open to all schools in the UK. The aim is to encourage the study of Physics and recognise excellence in young physicists through twelve annual Physics and Astronomy & Astrophysics competitions. The competitions are designed to test understanding and problem solving

skills and are open to able young physicists.

This year a total of 290 schools took part and 5,585 pupils and AGSB were awarded 8 Gold medals, 7 Silver medals and 4 Bronze medals. A special mention goes to Alex V (12SM) who got Gold medal and came top out of all of the 5,585 pupils who took part! AGSB were also top with our results.



This is an absolutely amazing result and the students were supported by Mr Reeder and Mr Suthard who ran an Olympiad support session every Monday lunchtime! Cambridge University who organise this competition said that they were extremely impressed with AGSB's scores and results.



3D Printer Success for Design & Technology



Our Year 12 Engineers have bid successfully for £1,000 worth of rapid prototyping hardware to support their research project. Aiyush G (12PT), Gautham R (12SM), Alex V (12SM), Seb H (12EL) and Ibrahim J (12EL) all forwarded a research proposal to the Hack Club to fund a project based around electronics and fluid mechanics. Their aim is to construct a radio controlled car and simulate the air-flow using fluid mechanics that can be simulated in Fusion 360, an industry standard CAD package that we use in

Design and Technology. The rapid prototyping hardware will be used to manufacture the car body parts ready for testing.

We are excited to have taken delivery of two different 3D printer types. One uses thermoplastic to build the designs in layers whilst the other uses the new resin and UV technology to provide higher resolution outcomes.
