Dear Parents, Carers and Students

As I write, a long-anticipated pause in the Middle East Conflict has come into effect. It is more important than ever to hold in our hearts, thoughts and prayers those caught up in this conflict and Mr Hall (Deputy Head) will be echoing these sentiments next week in assemblies.

As you are aware, in August AGSB celebrated record results at GCSE and A level. I would, however, like to draw Parents and Carers attention to a number of brief points at this juncture, if I may. The Department for Education have officially released their analysis of the 2023 exam results; we are extremely proud to announce that our School's Progress 8 score has been confirmed as 1.14 which places us in the top 1% of Schools nationally (for progress at GCSE). A score of +1 means that pupils at AGSB achieve one grade higher in each qualification than other similar pupils nationally. This is testament to the outstanding teaching and learning that takes place at AGSB each and every day.

My thanks to all AGSB Alumni who visited the School over the last two weeks. Our students benefit so much from hearing about 'real world' career pathways and experiences.

The co-curricular programme continues to gain pace and it is fantastic to observe the myriad of events taking place each lunchtime – many led by the students themselves. This week our whole School production of West Side Story takes centre stage, and I am look forward to attending this evening. I know how much hard work students and staff have put into this production and for each evening to be sold out is testament to the growing reputation of drama at AGSB.

In sport, students continue to excel in a range of sports. AGSB has enjoyed great success in recent weeks in table tennis, badminton, hockey, basketball, football and rugby. Special mention to the 1st XI football team who are through to the last 32 in the National Cup and the last 16 in the Greater Manchester Cup. Well done also to the Senior Indoor Hockey Squad who have reached the National Finals after defeating MGS in the Regional Final last Friday.

Finally, I sincerely believe all students at AGSB know in their hearts what it is to be a true 'Altrinchamian', especially in terms of living out the School value of 'Respect'. It is disappointing to report that although we celebrated Anti-bullying Week last week, there were a small number of instances involving students being unpleasant and hurtful to others. Our aim at AGSB is to create a positive culture that promotes excellent behaviour and positive relationships, ensuring that all students have the opportunity to learn in a calm, safe and supportive environment. As the Lebanese-American thinker and poet Kahlil Gibran said: "Tenderness and kindness are not signs of weakness and despair, but manifestations of strength and resolution".

Geography Field Trip



Last week the Geography Department took the whole of Year 9 off timetable to investigate the effects of regeneration on Salford. The students were given a short talk in school prior to departure providing them with a fascinating insight to the changes that Salford has gone through over the last 200 years.

Once the students arrived at Media City, they were given a tour of the major landmarks that have been built since the early 2000's and had the opportunity to collect some primary data. They were able to conduct Environmental Quality Surveys as well as think about the different user groups for the sites they were investigating. After a short lunch break the students were back at it, hard at work conducting pedestrian counts and surveys. This data will then be used in the classroom to write up a Geographical enquiry to ascertain how sustainable the regeneration of Salford has been. Overall, the students had a

great time conducting fieldwork for the time and the teachers were very grateful that it did not rain!


