Dear Parents, Carers and Students

The last two weeks have been especially sad in School as we have said goodbye to both exam groups. Examination Leave has begun for Year 11 and Year 13 and the Coleman Hall is now being used exclusively for exams until the end of June. I should like to take this opportunity of wishing both Year Groups all the very best in the exam season. Year 13, who were dressed in their old AGSB blazers, enjoyed a traditional Leavers' Breakfast and it was fitting that the Chairman of the Old Altrinchamian's, Christian James, was present to say a few words on the importance of staying in touch. I look forward to seeing Year 11 when they return for their Sixth Form Taster Day (Tuesday 28<sup>th</sup> June) which is designed to help them prepare for life in the Sixth Form.

At a strategic level, a key focus has been to make improvements to the School Estate. As you are aware, in September we launched the Sports for All - Making a Difference campaign to improve our outdoor Sports facilities. I would like to thank those members of the parental body who have attended the receptions to date. Your help and support has been incredible and we are making excellent progress towards our target of £1 million.

I will share more news once we have final costings for various improvements, but the initial news is that Government Grants (Condition Improvement Fund – a fund for Academies for which we have to bid) of just under £1 million are enabling us to add a new perimeter fence around the School to help us secure the site and to put in a new heating system across the School.

You may have been aware that it was 'Mental Health Awareness Week' last week. The Head Prefect, students and staff delivered an excellent assembly on raising awareness of mental health and I reminded the School community that support is always available at AGSB for any students who are struggling in any way. At AGSB we have a fully trained School Counsellor who can provide one to one support for pupils on a variety of topics. We also have 11 staff who are Mental Health First Aid Trained (this includes all the Heads of Year).

Elsewhere in School life, in a competitive year, Seb and Tosin (Y9) have won the Regional round of the Performing Shakespeare Competition. They now progress to the National Final at The Globe in London at the end of June – an amazing achievement.

I travelled to watch the Year 8 football XI play in the final of the Trafford Cup on Tuesday. After a spirited performance, they unfortunately lost 2-3 to Wellington. It has been a busy week in Tennis with a good deal of success against Wilmslow and St Ambrose and I wish our Cricket sides the best of fortune against Sandbach School tomorrow. A reminder that all parents are very welcome to come into School to support their son during sporting fixtures.








What an amazing Y10 House Tug O'War competition last week -100% commitment and effort displayed by all! Well done to Bradbury House who won by a narrow margin.
