A Level Spanish trip to Madrid

I am writing to inform you that the Spanish Department are organising a trip to Madrid with the company **Educational Spain** for year 10 students of Spanish; (those currently in year 9 who are opting to study Spanish GCSE next year). The trip will be in November 2026 for 3 nights; **Monday 9th November to Thursday 12th November 2026.**

The trip will provide the students with a rich cultural experience in the vibrant and dynamic capital city as they will have the chance to see some famous sites and attractions. The students will also have the opportunity to practise their Spanish as they explore Madrid and enhance their language skills by attending a short language course at a local language school.

The trip will include the following in the final price:

- Return flights from Manchester-Madrid including one piece of 10kg luggage per person
- 3 nights' accommodation in central Madrid (**breakfast and evening meal included**)
- Hotel accommodation in single beds twin/triple/quad rooms with private bathroom
- 4-hour Spanish class at a local language school (including photocopied materials)
- Tour of Santiago Bernabéu Stadium
- Entrance to the Reina Sofia Museum where Picasso's Guernica is on display
- Return train tickets to Toledo for a day trip to this stunning medieval city and entrance to the cathedral
- Insurance
- AOL protection

There could be an opportunity to attend a football match to watch Real Madrid at the Bernabeu stadium if fixtures coincide; this would incur an extra cost and a letter will be sent out regarding this when the tour company confirm.

Cost

At current flight prices the trip will cost **£885.00** based on 20 students and two members of staff, the cost of the trip will be reduced if more pupils wish to go.

We wish to make it clear that if the visit takes place, no student will be denied participation on the grounds that no contribution has been made on their behalf. However, please be aware, if insufficient contributions are made, we will be unable to proceed with the trip.
