Venue – Manchester High School for Girls

Saturday 7th February – Arrive at 09:00am for registration with AGSB staff. Mr Whiting will be there to meet you. Another member of staff (TBC) will swap with Mr Whiting at about 12:30 and supervise until day one finishes at 3:45. Please ensure parent/carers are there promptly to collect the pupils at this time.

Sunday 8th February – Arrive at 09:00am for registration with AGSB staff. Mr Wright will be there to meet you and supervise until day two finishes at 2:30. Please ensure parent/carers are there promptly to collect the pupils at this time.

Travel arrangements – Pupils will make their own plans to travel to and from the event. Parent lifts, lift sharing or public transport. If you require any assistance (financial or otherwise) organising transport for the event please let me know asap. At the conclusion of the MUN event, it is hoped that parent/carers will collect the pupils, if pupils are intending to make their own way home, it is essential that I am informed in advance of the event.

Cost

The cost of the conference is £37. We wish to make it clear that if the visit takes place, no student will be denied participation on the grounds that no contribution has been made on their behalf.
