Manchester Chinatown Trip

The Chinese department is going to lead a trip to Manchester Chinatown for our Y10 students to explore the second largest Chinatown in Europe. A variety of activities are planned for the students to practise the Chinese language they have learnt, explore those interesting shops around Chinatown, and experience a traditional Chinese Hot Pot meal. This trip will take place on Friday 23rd May 2025. We will travel by tram and our students will be accompanied by Mrs Ding and Mr Smith.

12.30pm	Traditional Chinese hot pot meal at Chuan Guo Xiang restaurant, address: 45-47 Faulkner Street (upper ground floor), Manchester M1 4EE
2	Block and the second state of the second state
2pm	Photography competition: Spot the Chinese influence in Manchester
2.40pm	Tram from St. Peter's Square to Altrincham
3.20pm	Dismiss at the main entrance of school
