

THE SCHOOL

Altrincham Grammar School for Boys is a multi-ethnic seven-form entry 11-18 selective Academy School. It caters for boys who have been selected for a grammar school education from a wide area of South Manchester and North Cheshire. Pupils travel to the School from Wilmslow, Knutsford, Lymm, Warrington, Sale, Urmston, Old Trafford and Cheadle Hulme.

The number of boys in the School has been rising steadily in recent years as its popularity has increased. In September 2021, there were 1345 boys in the school of whom 402 are in the Sixth Form. The School is very popular with parents and in the current year received over 1,300 applications for 202 places.

The academic results are outstanding and they place the School in the top 25 maintained schools in the country. Our GCSE results are strong in respect of 9/8 grades and our 'A' level results in respect of A*/A/B grades. The 2007 Ofsted Report graded the School as 'outstanding'.

We have the highest expectations of our students, not only in their academic performance, but in their commitment to extra-curricular activities be it in sport, drama, music or wider community service.

We are a school that values diversity and individual contribution; supporting and encouraging both students and staff to pursue their interests and achieve their ambitions.

An investment of £4M in improved sports facilities has been completed and all School employees benefit from free use of the facilities.

There are exciting times ahead at AGSB. In September 2020, the school moved from six to seven-form entry. In December 2020, work was completed on a state of the art £2.8 million teaching complex with is located in the heart of the School.



THE LOCATION

Altrincham Grammar School for Boys is situated a mile from Altrincham town centre within the Parish of Bowden, and close to the surrounding parishes of Hale, Altrincham and Timperley. The surrounding area is a desirable place to live and work. The School prides itself on its excellent relationship with the local community and parents. These are important factors that have contributed to the School's success and enable pupils to reach their full potential both academically and personally.

Ten miles from Manchester city centre and thirty miles from Liverpool and Chester, the area is served by an excellent motorway network and the Manchester Metrolink rail. Manchester International Airport is sited in the east of the School's catchment area, five miles from Altrincham town centre. Wythenshawe Teaching Hospital, a pioneer in advanced surgery, is sited just outside the catchment area to the north. The School has strong connections with Manchester University and Manchester Metropolitan University both through teacher training links and through links with academic departments.

Manchester is a cosmopolitan centre of international commerce, arts, music, theatre, opera, ballet, sports, museums and events. The Bridgewater Hall in Manchester is the home of the Hallé Orchestra, there are numerous venues for major rock concerts, and the city centre theatres regularly host major West End productions. Old Trafford, home of Manchester United Football Club and Lancashire Cricket Club, is within easy reach of Altrincham.



THE TECHNOLOGY DEPARTMENT

The Technology Department consists of four workshops, a Food and Nutrition room and an electronics laboratory.

Our team of seven dedicated staff offers a suite of GCSE and A-Level options.

We have installed a selection of CAM equipment including CNC Milling Machines and a Laser Cutter to support our teaching across all year groups and we encourage our students to work collaboratively and think creatively which has led to great success in design competitions at a National and International level such as Teen Tech and The Big Bang.

Our Technical Teaching Assistant is able to work alongside the teaching team to realise outstanding outcomes and provide 1:1 support for individual pupils where necessary.

We operate an open workshop policy which enables KS5 pupils to work alongside lower school pupils which allows them to further their design projects whilst providing support at the same time and our workshops are also open during lunchtimes so that all pupils can work in the area should they choose to do so.



THE ROLE
