## **Beginning of the Spring Term 2021 Arrangements**

### **Testing Requirements for Years 7-11**

- Students should take a lateral flow test at home, up to three days before the return to school.
- In addition to this, students will also compete a lateral flow test in school on Monday 10<sup>th</sup> January (please see the testing Rota below).

## **Testing Requirements for 6th Form pupils**

- 6th Form students will not receive a school based lateral flow test but will be expected to complete two lateral flow tests at home. Students should take one test up to three days before the return to school date and one test on the morning of the 10<sup>th</sup> January 2022.
- 6th Form students will return to face-to-face education as usual on Monday 10<sup>th</sup> January (as long as they have completed two home based lateral flow tests and received negative results).
- Sixth Form Students must register their own test using the NHS QR code on their home testing kits

#### Please note:

- Pupils should only arrive for their allocated testing time.
- Pupils must enter school through the student entrance and move immediately to the **Coleman Hall** where they will queue as a form in alphabetical order.
- After their testing slot, pupils will return to school for the rest of the day.
- Any pupils being tested after lunch, will not have access to the dining facilities and therefore must either bring a packed lunch, or eat before they arrive at school.
- Due to the scale of the operation and the associated administrative challenges, *there is no flexibility on the date or the time that pupils are being tested.*

#### **Consent for Years 7-11**

• We will be using the same consent gathered as part of our previous LFD testing process.

#### **International Travel**

• If any of our students/families are travelling internationally, it is paramount you are aware of the latest travel restrictions. The guidance is ever changing but those returning from international travel will require a PCR test and some level of post travel isolation.
