1. For Parents and Y 12 Students : Higher Education Evening on Tuesday 29th

The Evening will cover some important issues concerning University applications. There will also be the opportunity to hear the perspective of an external speaker from Liverpool University. The Evening will commence at 7.00 pm in the Coleman Hall. It should last around an hour and the format will be as follows:

Ms B Barritt - Choosing University Courses and What Admissions Tutors look for in applications;

Dr J Marsden - Timetable for University applications;

Mr T Murray - Preparing to apply.

2. For Year 12 Students: UCAS Higher Education Exhibition - afternoon of Wednesday , March 6th

This takes place at the Manchester Convention Centre. All Year 12 may attend. There is no charge for entry to the event, but the School has a pre-booked entry time of Wednesday 6th March 12-30 until 14-30.

Students will be permitted to leave after p3, to get there by 1 or 1-15, which will still give them plenty of time to see exhibitors. Students need to logon and follow the booking procedure to get a ticket either electronically or in hard copy (see overleaf for how to do this).

Students will be free to leave School from the end of morning lessons, will travel to and from the event independently and cover their cost of travel. These conventions consistently attract hundreds of exhibitors across the network, such as Universities, colleges, charities, gap year companies, recruiters and organisations, all united in their aim to inform and advise 16-17 year olds on their future options. The Convention provides the ideal opportunity for Year 12 students to talk to exhibitors who can provide information and advice on their future choice of course, institution of study and career options. Students who do not want to attend the event, or fail to return the parental permission slip below will be expected to attend supervised private study during Period 4 and will be free to leave school at 2.25pm. (*Please also note that parents may attend this or any session and can book as individuals via the UCAS website*).

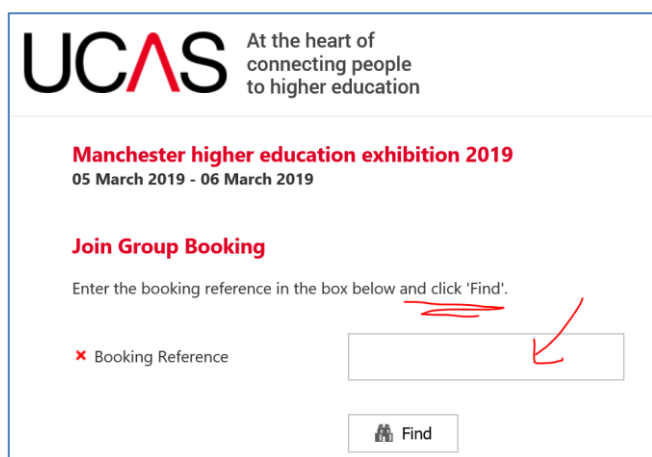
