

**Consultation on the revision of the School's Admission Policies for entry into Years 7-11 and
the 6th Form from September 2022
5 October 2020 – 7 December 2020 at 3.30pm**

Consultation

We would like to hear your views on:

- A proposed change to the Year 7 entrance exam (for applicants sitting the entrance exam from September 2021 onwards);
- A proposed change to in-year transfer applications to alter the provision for “looked after”/previously “looked after” applicants and applicants who meet the Pupil Premium Criteria;
- A proposed change to the 6th Form Admissions Policy to alter the provision for external applicants who meet the Pupil Premium criteria.

Altrincham Grammar School for Boys (“AGSB”) is proposing to join the Trafford Grammar Schools CEM Consortium (currently comprising Altrincham Grammar School for Girls, Sale, Stretford and Urmston Grammar Schools). This would provide applicants to AGBS with the opportunity to apply to both AGBS and other grammar schools within the Consortium through one application process and to sit the same CEM entrance exam on the same day at a number of different exam venues.
