Dear Parents and Carers

As we approach half term, I am writing with a reminder of some essential public health messages, as we work together to keep the AGSB community safe.

As you are aware, from 00:01 on Friday 23rd October Greater Manchester will move into the highest tier of Coronavirus restrictions.

Social interactions out of school

Under Tier 3 local lockdown rules:

- You must not socialise with anybody outside of your household unless they are in your support bubble in any indoor setting or in any private garden or at most outdoor hospitality venues and ticketed events.
- You must not socialise in a group of more than 6 in an outdoor public space such as a park or beach, the countryside, a public garden or a sports venue.
- Places of worship remain open, but household mixing is not permitted.
- You should avoid staying overnight in another part of the UK if you are resident in a very high alert level area, or avoid staying overnight in a very high alert level area if you are resident elsewhere.
